

CREDITS FROM LACONIA ACADEMY

The Laconia School Board endorses the availability of the Laconia Academy Program, also known as the Laconia Adult High School Diploma Program, for Laconia High School students. In doing so the Board recognizes that some students can and will benefit from taking courses through the Laconia Academy Program.

Board Policy is that Laconia Academy credits may be applied toward the 20 ¼ credit requirements for a Laconia High School graduation based on the following:

- Laconia Academy Course options are available only with the prior approval of the Laconia High School Principal to juniors or seniors who are presently carrying a full course load or have unusual circumstances.
- Students wishing to take Laconia Academy courses must receive prior approval from their Guidance Counselor, High School Principal, and the Director of Adult Education.
- One high school credit will be granted for a one semester Laconia Academy course, provided a passing grade is earned.
- A total of two credits will be accepted from the Laconia Academy Adult Education Program toward the fulfillment of credits needed to meet Laconia High School graduation requirements.
- The cost of any Laconia Academy courses will be borne by the students, parents, or guardians.
