

**ACCESS TO LACONIA SCHOOL DISTRICT PROGRAMS BY  
NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS**

Each non-public student who would otherwise be considered a resident student that wishes to take advantage of the curricular courses and/or co-curricular programs in the Laconia School District will do the following:

- A. If a student is below the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level the parent/guardian must notify the Principal of the school in writing that their child wishes to participate in a course or program. The Principal will be in touch with the parent/guardian with the information necessary for the student to take part in the requested activity.
- B. The non-public pupil will be given the same opportunities as any other student in the district to participate in the curricular and co-curricular activities. The non-public pupils will be subject to the same rules, regulations, and requirements.
- C. If the non-public pupil is in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or above he/she will be required to follow the NHIAA regulations governing non-public pupil participation.
