The Laconia School Board held a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, May 19, 2015, at the Harvard Street, SAU Board Room. Present: Mal Murray, Stacie Sirois, Barbara Luther, Mike Persson, Scott Vachon, Chris Guilmett, Joe Cormier, Business Administrator Ed Emond, and Assistant Superintendent Kirk Beitler. Absent: Superintendent Terri Forsten.

CALL TO ORDER

Board Chair Joe Cormier called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. The agenda was posted on May 18, 2015, at the SAU office and on the district's website, along with being sent to each of our schools, "The Citizen", Laconia Library, and City Hall, in accordance with RSA 91-A.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

PRESENTATION

Facility Update at LHS

Asst. Superintendent Kirk Beitler and Business Administrator Ed Emond presented the changes occurring to the Math Wing or Silver Wing and Auditorium Wing or Red Wing at Laconia High school during the summer of 2015.

Understanding by Design

Elementary Academic Coordinator of Teaching and Learning Gail Bourn, LMS Academic Coordinator of Teaching and Learning Alison Bryant and LHS Academic Coordinator of Teaching and Learning Steve Tucker presented to the School Board on Understanding by Design and the impact on our schools. Ms. Bryant explained UbD and how teachers use it in our schools. Ms. Bourn explained the Professional Development that has been offered to teachers and Mr. Tucker explained about implementation in our schools. Ms. Forsberg and Ms. McCallum, 4th Grade teachers, introduced students Kayden Dolloff and Ethan Vachon who explained a UbD lesson the Laconia Elementary Schools collaborated on collectively about government and writing a bill. LMS teachers Jessica Peterson and Ryan Theman along with students Elijah and Jillian presented a UbD lesson on number sense. The lesson tied in everyday life lessons with a project about the New England Patriots. Elijah talked about how he preferred this type of assessment rather than a test and he feels that he will remember the information longer than if he studied for a test. LHS science teacher Ivy Leavitt-Carlson presented with Kate Persson on a cell unit and LHS English Teacher presented with Nikki on literary circles.

BOARD COMMITTEE REPORTS

Budget & Personnel: This group attended the City Council meeting on Monday, May 11th. There was discussion with City Council on cutting money from the budget. They will meet together to discuss.

Facilities/CIP: This group has not met but they discussed the presentation from the meeting and discussed how the wings were renamed. **Policy:** This group met on May 13th to begin reviewing handbooks.
